## Let it Snow, Let it Snow, Let it Snow!

- **Keep the sidewalk in front of your property clear.** Shovel the snow into your yard and enjoy the benefits in the spring after it melts!
- **Do not shovel the snow into the street.** This inhibits proper drainage and can cause a big mess.
- Remember that the Town will only plow the streets if there is accumulation of at least 6" on the ground with a projection of more to come within the next twelve hours.

- \* Please see calendar below for trash pickup days.
- waste cans. Put them off to the side with **ALL** decorations removed.
- and New Years. Bundle or bag your extra trash and place 3 feet from your cans by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled trash day. We will take care of the rest!
- \* The Yard Waste Program will resume on March 5th. Remember not to put trash in your brown can.
- \* If you miss the Christmas Tree pickup, you can put your trees out on your extra trash day (the 3rd trash day of the month).
- \* Please have 3 feet between each can and other obstacles where possible. Our trash trucks need a bit more room to avoid knocking cans over or causing property damage.
- \* Please make sure to always have your cans out by 6 a.m.
- \* Back by popular demand! **EXTRA EXTRA** trash is coming the week **between** Christmas
- \* Please do not put your Christmas trees in your green
