Please separate your cans 3 feet apart to avoid damages

### Holiday Trash Schedule:

There will be no changes to your regularly scheduled trash day.

### Yard Waste:

For your **BROWN** can. Please do not put any trash, plastic bags, or doggy poop in this can. It is for clippings and yard refuse only. Large branches need to be cut down and cannot stick out of the top. Green Waste is picked up on Thursday. Please have your cans out by 6:00am.

### Extra Trash Day:

Your 3rd trash pickup of the month. Set the extra trash off to the side of your cans. Please do not put the extra trash in the Brown can. This too must be put out by 6:00am.

### Reminders From Public Works
