Holiday Trash Notes

****Please see calendar below for trash pickup schedule and Christmas Tree Pickup.**

****Please ALWAYS have your cans out by 6:00am.**

****Yard Waste Program will resume on Thursday, March 2, 2023.**

****Do not put your Christmas tree in your green waste can. Save them for tree pickup day and remove all ornaments, tinsel and other decorations.**

****Extra, EXTRA trash pickup will be the week between Christmas and New Years, on your regularly scheduled trash pickup day.**

****On all extra trash days, be sure to bundle or bag your trash 3 feet away from your regular can by 6:00am.**



Important Notes

****Do NOT blow leaves from your yard into the streets. This clogs the street drains and prevents proper snow melt.**

****Residents are responsible for keeping the sidewalk in front of their property clear.**

****Do NOT shovel snow into the streets. Shovel it onto your lawn and your grass will thank you in the spring!**

****The Town only plows the streets if there is an accumulation of at least 4 inches on the ground with the projection of more snow coming.**
