Backflow testing is required annually by the State of Nevada and the Town of Minden. If you have a backflow device on your water system, please provide us with a copy of your current test results as soon as they are completed.

Please do not place any embers in your trash can unless they are completely extinguished and slurried with water. Hot or smoldering embers can pose a serious fire hazard to your cans and our trash trucks. For more information on what is allowed in your trash and yard waste cans, please refer to our trash policies on our website.

Due to increased winds in our area, please do your due diligence before requesting a replacement for missing trash or yard waste cans. If your can goes missing after being emptied, check with your neighbors first before contacting our office.
