TRASH TIPS TO KEEP THINGS ROLLING SMOOTHLY!

A quick reminder to help keep our trash service running clean and trouble-free:

- Give Your Cans Some Personal Space to ensure pick-up
please place your cans at least 3 feet apart and 5 feet away from obstacles like cars, fences, mailboxes, and other items. This gives the truck plenty of room to grab and empty them safely.



- Bag It to Beat the Freeze

Make sure all garbage is bagged before going into the can. This helps prevent loose, wet trash from freezing to the bottom—otherwise it may not come out when the truck dumps it, leaving you with some very unwanted “leftovers” for next week! Do

- Final Yard Waste Pickup

The last Yard Waste (brown can) pickup of the season is December 26th. Service will resume the first Thursday of April next year. Please do NOT bag yard waste.

Don't Let Your Trash Be a Grinch! Christmas and New Years Pick-Up Schedule

- Trash pick-up on December 24th and December 31st will cover the following areas: Mackland, Aspen Grove, Westwood, Minden Town Homes, Winhaven, Minden Loop, Wildrose, Deseret, and County Road. Be sure to have your cans out by 6:00 AM to ensure pick-up.
- December 30th is Extra Xtra Trash Day. Includes all Neighborhoods. Please place 3 feet from cans.
- Yard Waste Pick-Up is December 26th and will be the last pick-up of the year. Please have out by 6:00 AM.
- Christmas Tree Collection will take place on Friday, January 2nd & 9th. Please have trees out by 6:00 AM. Trees must be NAKED, you heard that right, FREE of Tinsel, Lights, and Ornaments. NO Artificial Trees are allowed and will not be picked up.

Don't Let Your Pipes Catch a Cold!

Winter is here, and it's time to show your irrigation system a little love! Please remember to properly winterize your irrigation to prevent frozen pipes, leaks, and costly repairs.

Planning plumbing work?

If you don't currently have a shutoff valve at your water connection, it's a smart idea to have your plumber install one. It can save time, money, and stress down the road.

Meter Pit Reminder (This Is Important!)

There is a fine for entering Town meter pits. This applies to homeowners and hired plumbers. For safety and system protection, Town staff are the only ones authorized to access meter pits.

Need your water turned off?

Please call the Town office to schedule a water shutoff. If you have a plumber scheduled, be sure to contact the Town and schedule the shutoff at least 24 hours prior to your plumbing appointment. Our staff are the only ones authorized to operate the meter pits and will be happy to assist.

A LITTLE PREPARATION NOW CAN PREVENT A BIG SPLASH LATER. THANKS FOR HELPING US KEEP OUR WATER SYSTEM RUNNING SMOOTHLY!
