RATE INCREASES

During the May Board Meeting the Town Board approved rate increases to residential water and trash service. These increase will take effect on July 1, 2017. Included in these increases is a change to the cost of extra trash cans; the new rate for extra cans will be \$7.00 per quarter.

Also the Board approved a universal metering program, requiring meters to be paid for and installed on all connections by 2025. Additional information will be provided to all non-metered customers explaining the program.

TRASH TIPS (Excludes the Ranch @ Gardnerville)

Holiday Trash Schedule:

Please note that there is no trash pickup on Tuesday, July 4th for the holiday. Residents with Tuesday trash day need to have their cans out on Monday, July 3rd by 6am for pickup. Residents with a Wednesday or Thursday trash day are not affected for this holiday.

Yard Waste:

For your BROWN can. Please do not put any trash or plastic bags in this can. It is only for clippings and yard refuse. Large branches need to be cut down and cannot stick out of the top. Green Waste is picked up on Thursday. Please have your cans out by 6:00am.

Extra Trash Day:

Your 3rd trash pickup of the month. Set the extra trash off to the side of your cans. Please do not put the extra trash in the Brown can. This too must be put out by 6:00am.

Dumpsters:

If requesting a residential dumpster, you may be asked to fill out a liability waiver if you haven't already. A waiver needs to be signed before we can process the request. Please do not have items sticking out of the top.
